- If you click the **Number of Course Certificate** Tab, a new window will appear with the relevant information.

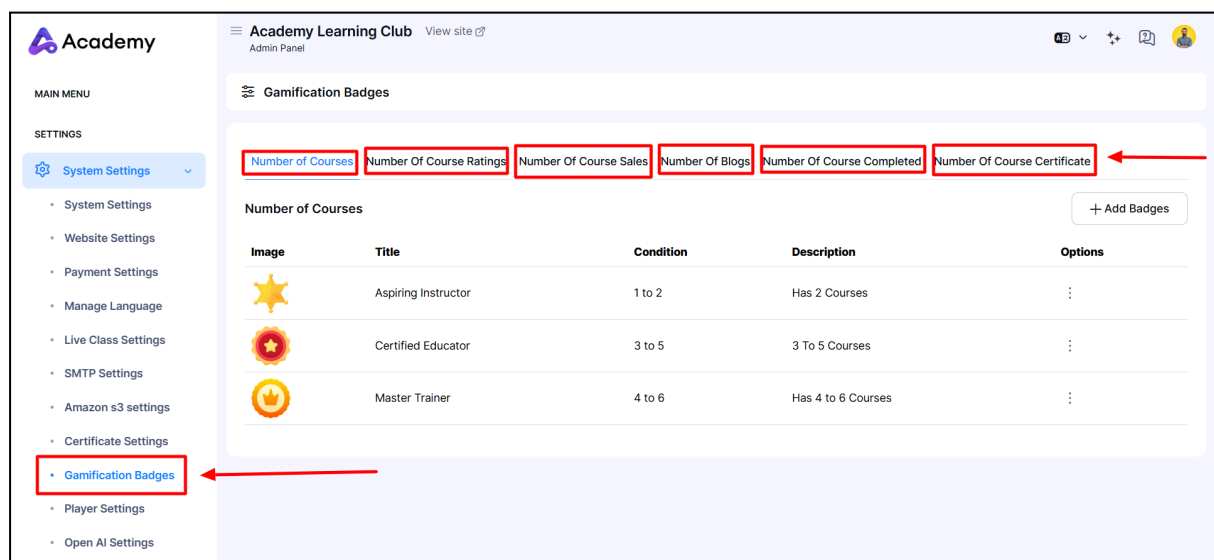


Figure- 1 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamification Badges-Manage Gamification Badges

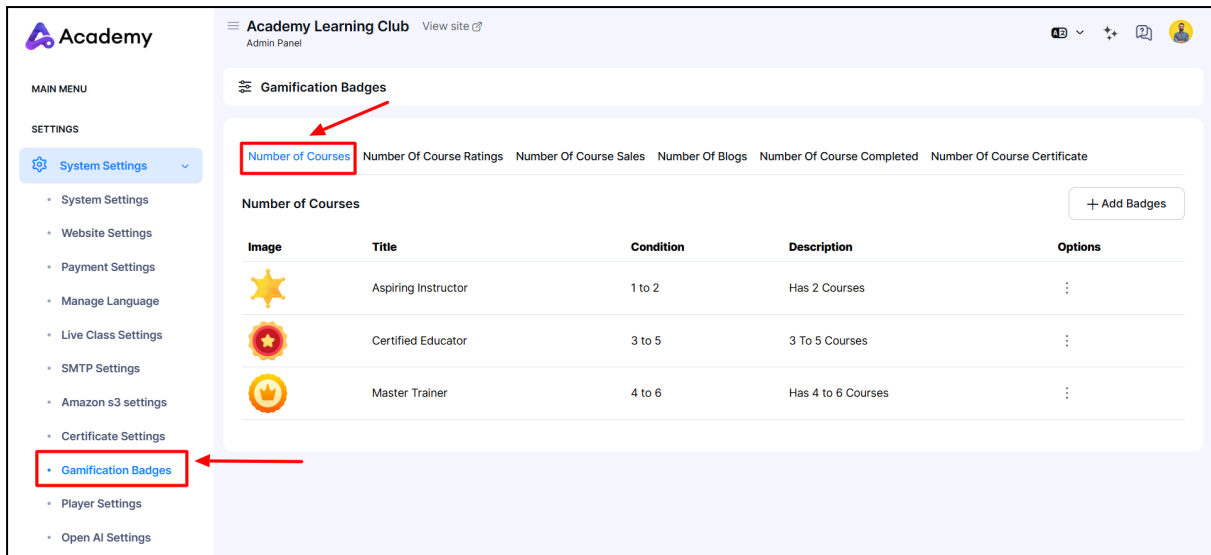


Figure- 2 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion Badges-Number of Courses

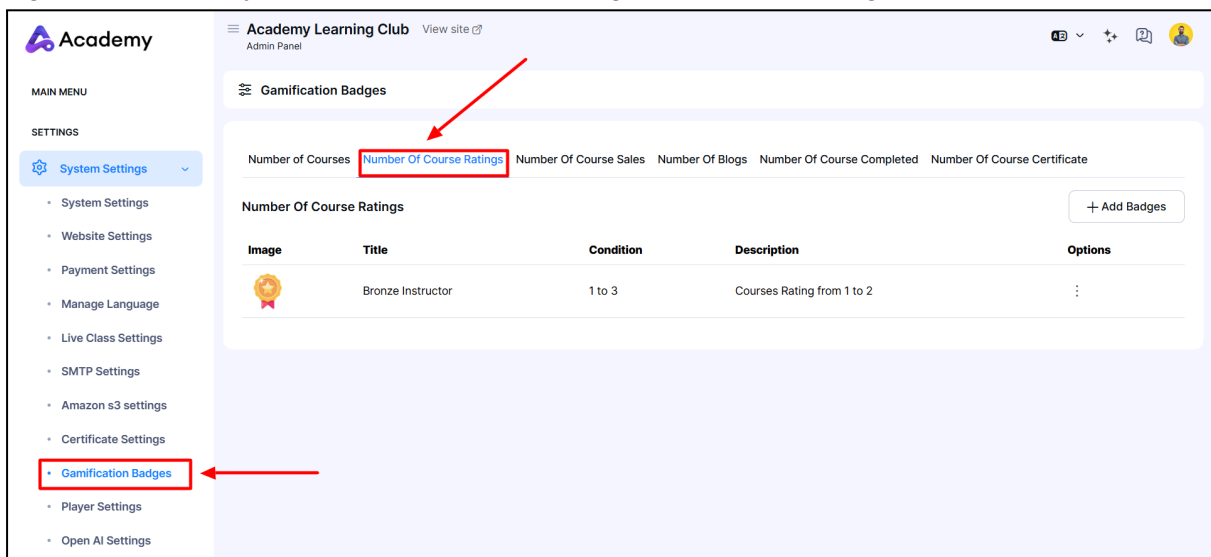


Figure- 3 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion Badges-Number of Course Ragtings

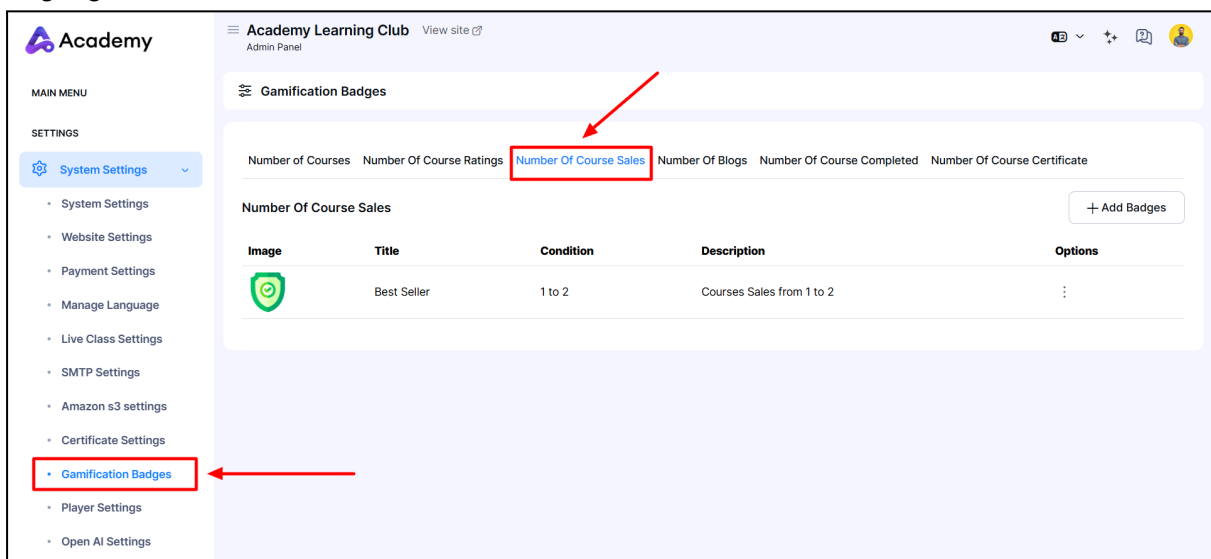


Figure- 4 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion Badges-Number of Course Sales

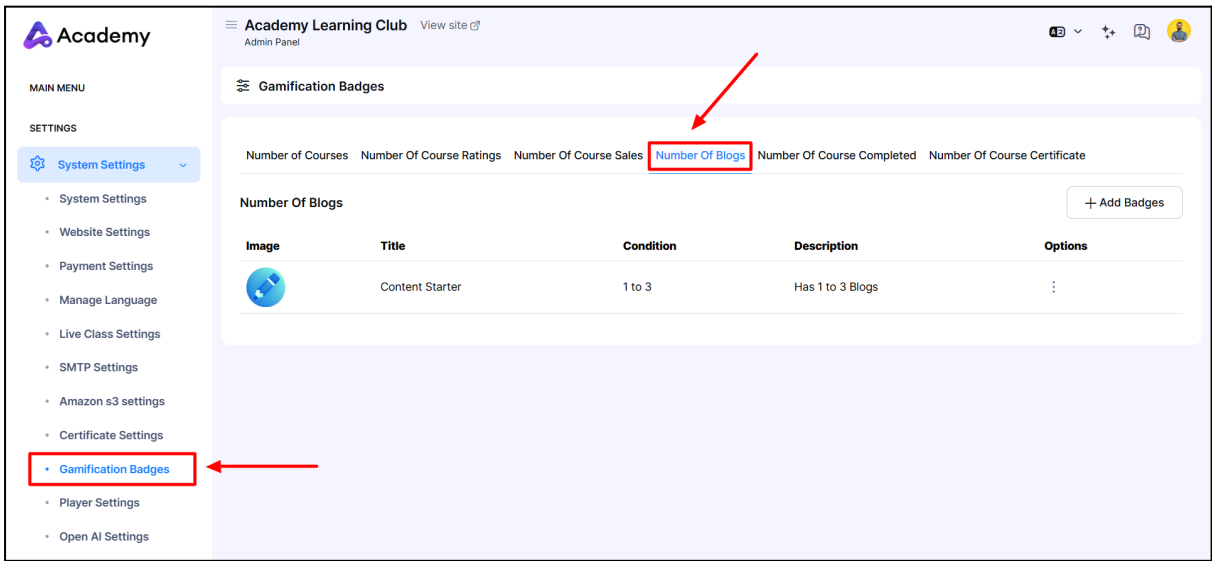


Figure- 5 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion Badges-Number of Blogs

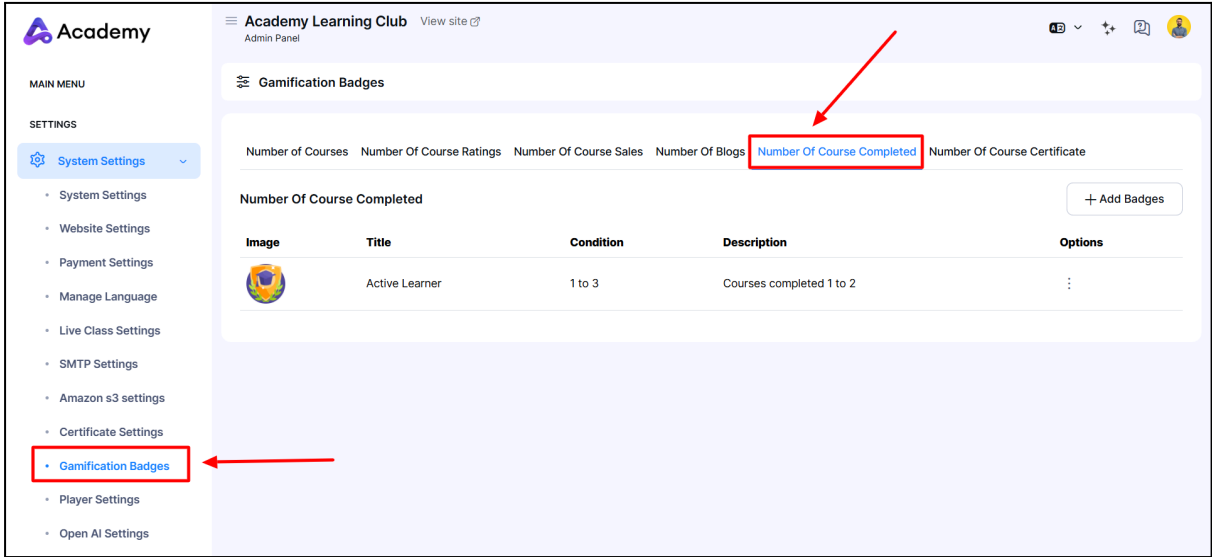


Figure- 6 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion-Number of Course Completed

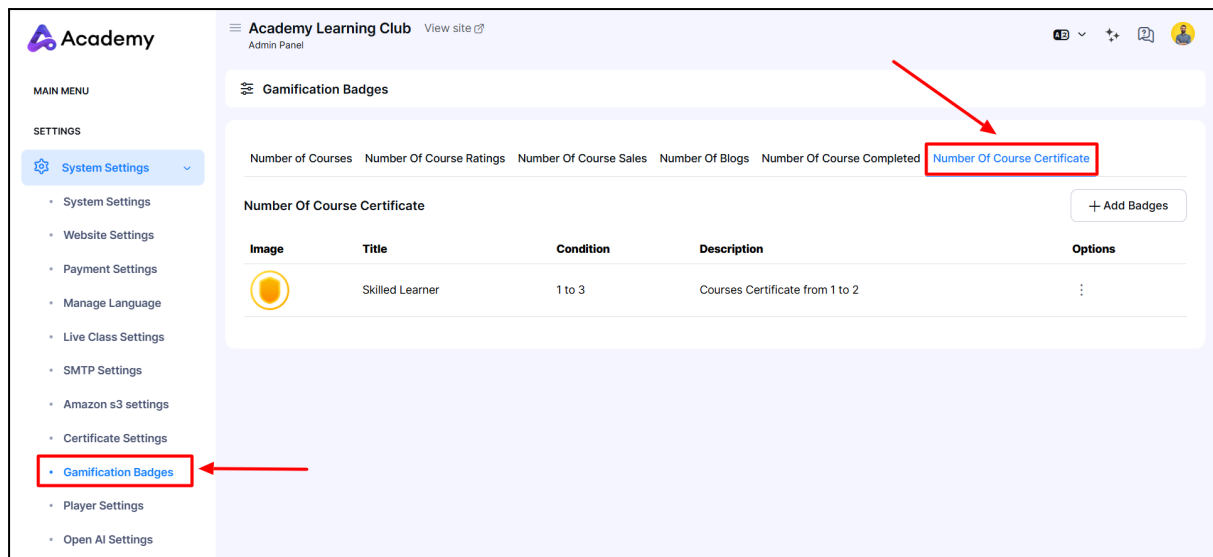


Figure- 7 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion-Number of Course Certificate

How to Add Badge

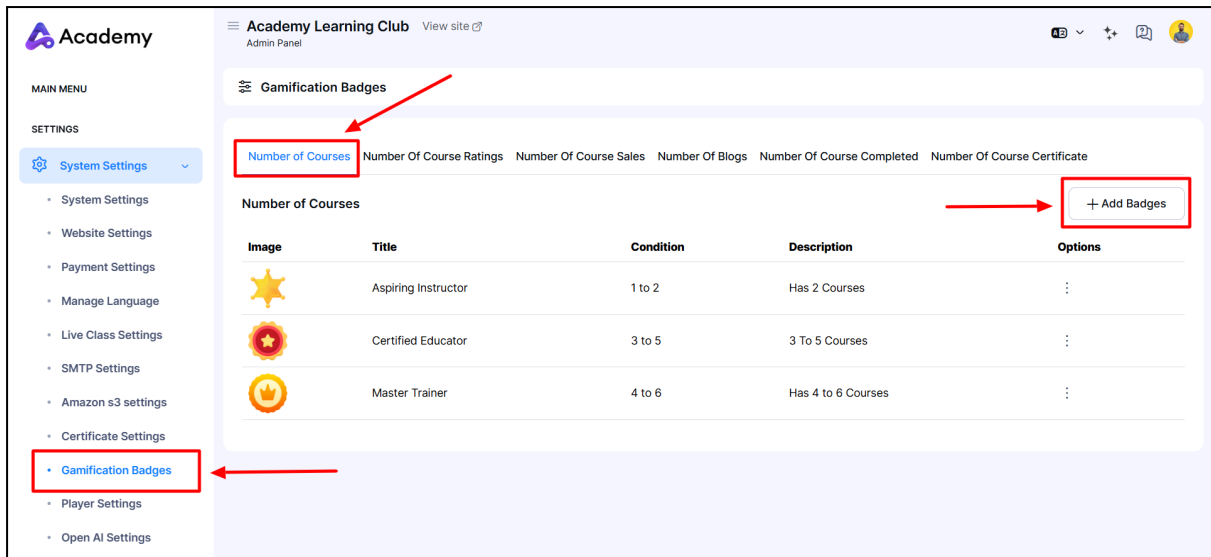


Figure- 8 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamificaion Badges-Add Badges

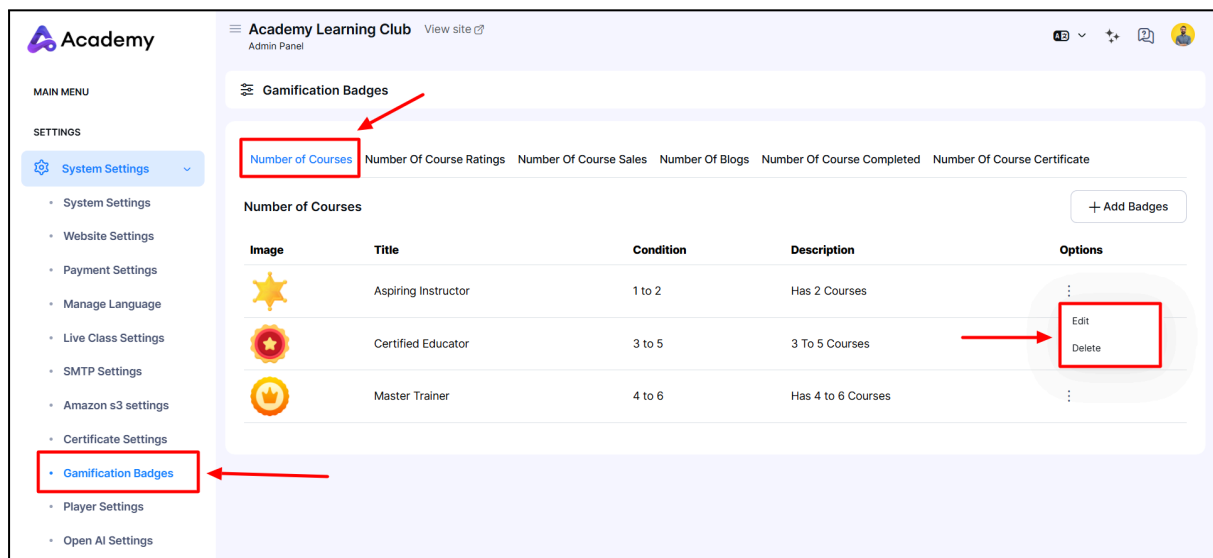


Figure- 10 Academy LMS Laravel-Admin-Settings-Gamification Badges-Edit Badges

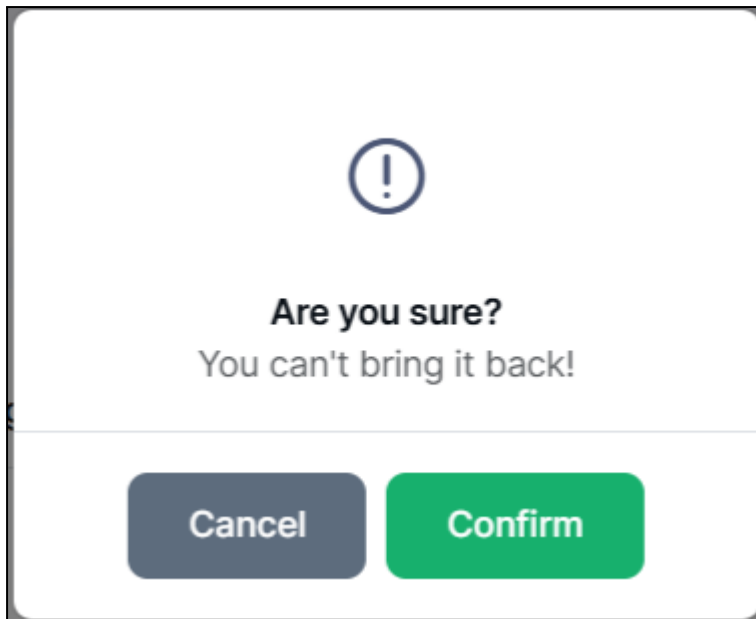


Figure- 12 Academy LMS Laravel-Settings-Gamification Badges-Confirm

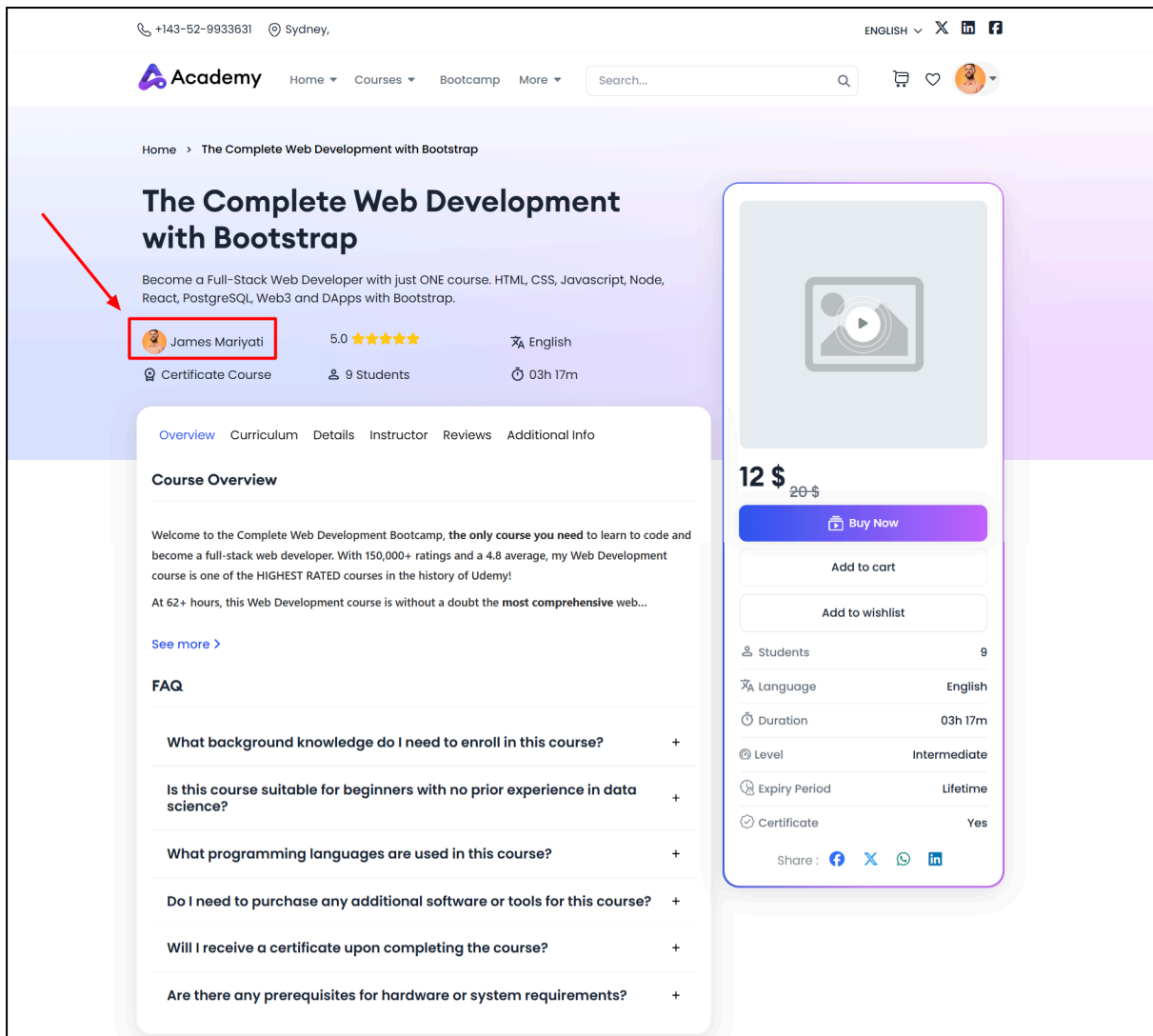


Figure- 15 Academy LMS Laravel-Instructor-Course-Manage Courses-Frontend View-View Badge

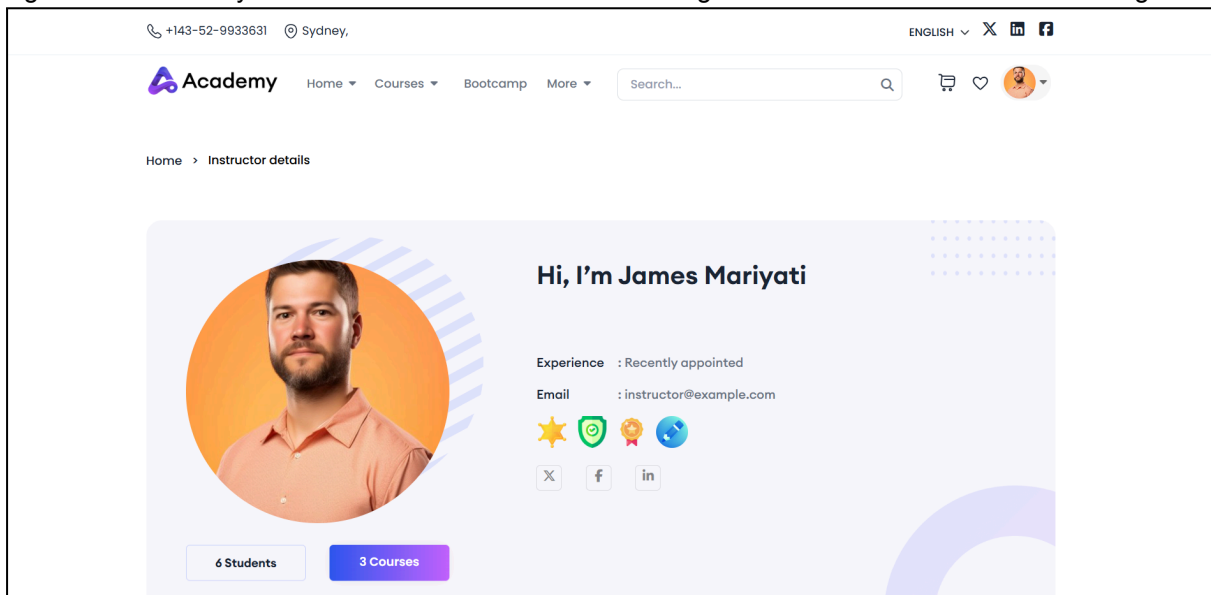


Figure- 16 Academy LMS Laravel-Instructor-Course-Manage Courses-Frontend View-Instructor Details-View Badges

- Finally, click **Badges** from the left menu, and a new window will appear with badges.

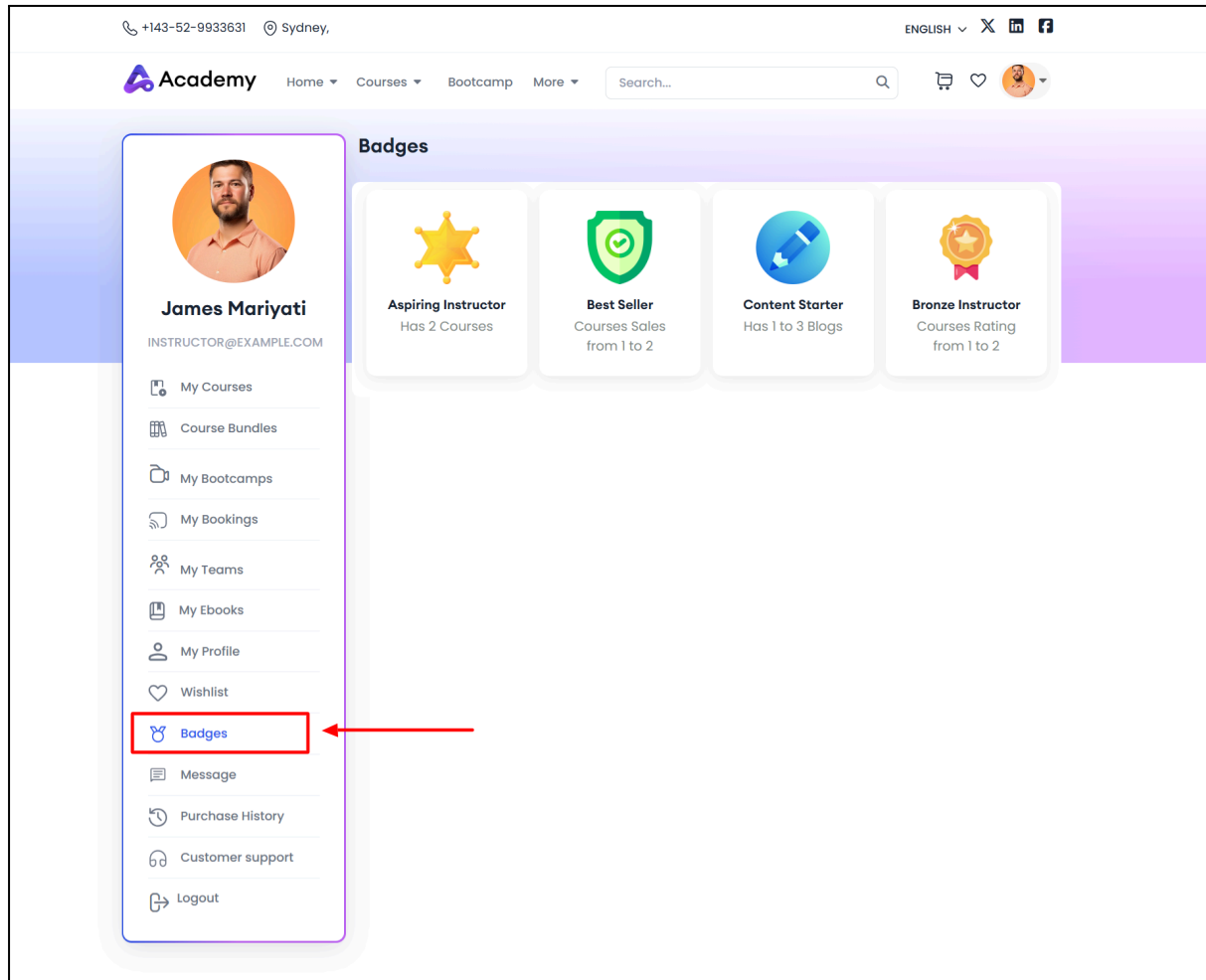


Figure- 17 Academy LMS Laravel-Instructor-My Courses-Badges

- Finally, click **Badges** from the left menu, and a new window will appear with badges.

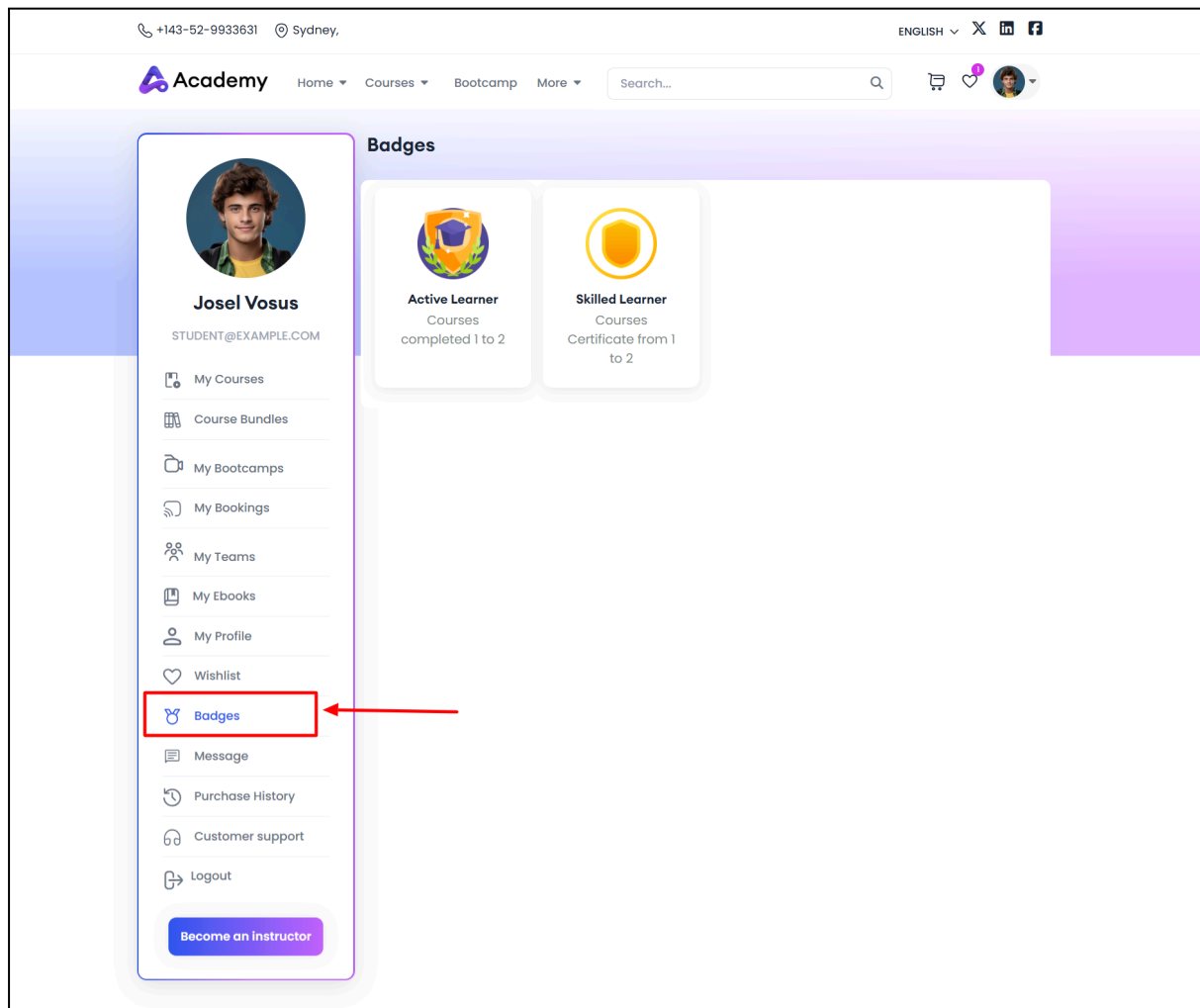


Figure- 18 Academy LMS Laravel-Student-My Courses-Badges
